Note: Candidates represented International/National level and achieved position but not possessing 10+2 educational qualification may also apply. However, candidature of such candidates will be subject to verification of sports credentials & performance during selection trials. Relaxation of educational qualification (Not Below Matric) will be considered on case to case basis for eligible candidates.

3. Date of Birth Block: Candidates should be born between 07 July 1997 to 27 June 2001 (both days inclusive). Upper age limit of date of enrolment is 21 years.

Note: Age relaxation (not below 16 years and not exceeding 25 years of age) would be considered in exceptional cases on 19. (a) Columns : All the columns in the application should be filled in capital letters. Do not split words. 4. Secretary, Air Force Sports Control Board reserves the right to shortlist the applications on the basis of the available vacancies

5. Medical Standards: (a) Height: Minimum acceptable height: 152.5 cm. (b) Chest: Minimum range of expansion: 5 cm. (c) Weight: Proportionate to height and age. (d) Vision: Minimum visual standard: Unaided 6/36, corrected to at least 6/9 for each eye with spectacles, Dioptectric power not exceeding ± 3.5 Dioptres in any axis. Full field of vision and Defective safe colour vision CP-II/III. Candidates should bring latest (within one month) prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. (e) Corneal Surgery (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable. (f) Hearing: Candidates should have normal hearing i.e., able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters with each ear separately. (g) Dental: Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points. (h) Health: Candidates should be free from Medical or Surgical deformity. He should be free from all communicable diseases and skin ailments. Candidates must be physically and mentally FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain. The candidates are advised to get wax removed from their ears and tartar and stains removed from their teeth before appearing for selection trials.

6. Body Tattoo: Permanent body tattoos are not permitted, however tattoo's only on inner face of the fore arms (inside of elbow to the wrist), Back (dorsal) part of the hand/reverse side of palm and Tribals with tattoos which are as per custom and traditions of their tribes may be considered. However, right to decide acceptability/unacceptability of the individual rest with Air Force Authorities /Secretary Air Force Sports Control Board. Candidate with permanent body tattoos are to submit two photographs (close up and distant view) with details of size and type of the tattoo.

7. Candidate discharged from the Indian Air Force for any reason earlier shall NOT APPLY.

# **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

8. Training & Tenure: Enrolment is for an initial period of 20 years extendable up to the age of 57 years. Initially candidates will be sent for a Joint Basic Phase Training (JBPT) at Basic training Institute, Belagavi (Karnataka). On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be allocated trades and sent for trade training of specified duration. Training is however liable to be terminated at any time if the trainee fails to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be medically unfit.

9. Pay & Allowances: During training, a stipend of Rs. 14,600/- per month will be paid. On completion of training, starting gross emoluments at the minimum of scale of pay including Military Service Pay (MSP) will be 26,900/- per month including Dearness Allowances (DA) as applicable which, in subsequent year, may rise as per career progression of the individual. Other allowances such as Transport allowance, Composite Personnel Maintenance allowance (CPMA), Leave Ration allowance (LRA), Fly/PJI allowance (If applicable), HRA, Children Education Allowance etc are also admissible time to time as applicable.

10. Perquisites: Perks such as Ration, Clothing, Medical facilities, Accommodation, CSD (Canteen) facilities, Leave (60 days Annual and 30 days casual in a calendar year as a privilege), Education concession to children, Recreational facilities, Transport facility to school going children and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) are also provided as per existing rules. Note withstanding the above, contributory Group Insurance cover of Rs. 37,50000 at premium of Rs. 2300/- per month is covered for all airmen and facility of Group Housing Scheme is also extended. Other facilities by Air Force Wives Welfare Association NC(E)? If YES, mention following details. (AFWWA) are also extended to family of airmen

11. Promotion: Promotion prospects exist up to the rank of Master Warrant Officer (MWO), Opportunities to become Commissioned Officer also exist for those airmen who qualify the prescribed examination, later during their service career.

12. Post Retirement Benefits. Pension, Gratuity, Leave Encashment, Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) and CSD (Canteen) facilities comprise some of the post retirement benefits. Specialised Pre-release Course (PRC) are also arranged to enable airmen to take up post retirement career. In addition, airmen also get relaxation in age and reservation in Govt. Services as ex-servicemen.

HOW TO APPLY

17. Application Form: APPLICATION SHOULD BE ON A4 SIZE PAPER ONLY IN THE PRESCRIBED FORMAT. Non-standard application forms will be rejected. The following are to be sent along with the application:-

(a) Three copies of unattested recent (not before 01 Feb 2018) passport size COLOUR PHOTOGRAPH (front portrait without headgear except for Sikhs), ONE of which is to be pasted on the application form and the other two are to be stapled to the top left corner of the application form. THE PHOTOGRAPH IS TO BE TAKEN WITH CANDIDATE HOLDING A BLACK SLATE IN FRONT OF HIS CHEST WITH HIS NAME, DATE OF BIRTH AND DATE OF PHO-TOGRAPH CLEARLY WRITTEN ON IT WITH WHITE CHALK IN CAPITAL LETTERS. Photographs should be only on good quality "Photo Paper."

(b) Attested copies of Matriculation Certificate in support of Date of Birth. Attested copies of Marks Sheet & Certificate of Education Qualification along with attested copies of Sports achievement certificates.

(c) One unstamped self addressed 24cm x 10 cm WHITE ENVELOPE of good quality, stapled/pinned with the application form.

18. Candidates are to bring with them the following at the time of selection trail:- (a) Four copies of photographs (same as submitted with the application). (b) Original Matriculation passing certificate with four attested photo copies for verification of date of birth. (c) Original Matriculation mark sheet with four attested copies. (d) Original passing certificate and mark sheet of Intermediate/10 +2 with four attested photo copies. (e) Original certificates regarding sports achievement with four attested photo copies. (f) Character Certificate. (g) Sports Kit. (h) For candidates discharged from Indian Army/Indian Navy/any other Government organisation.

(i) Original and four self attested photo copies of discharge certificates (as issued from Indian Army/Indian Navy/ Government organisation). (ii) Original and four self attested photo copies of NOC from the employer for candidates presently serving in any Government organisations (if applicable). (iii) Original and four self attested photocopies of NCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' certificate (if applicable).

13. Higher Education: Airmen are permitted to pursue higher educational qualification only after acquiring prescribed skill grade in their trade.

## SELECTION PROCEDURE

14. Selection Trials: Eligible candidates will be sent call letters for selection trials. The date and venue will be mentioned in call letter.

15. Selection trials will be conducted in following phases:-

### (a) Physical Fitness Test (PFT):

(i) PFT I - PFT I consists of a 1.6 Km run to be completed within 6 minutes 30 seconds for the candidates up to 25 years of age. Candidates are advised to bring their sports kit / playing kit / sports shoes and shorts.

(ii) PFT II - Candidates who qualify PFT I test will undergo PFT II that comprises of the following:

Test	Maximum time period	Remarks
10 Push Ups	01 Minute	Test will be conducted after 10 minutes break on completion of PFT I
10 Sit Ups	01 Minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of Push Ups
20 Squats	01 Minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of sit ups.

(b) Only PFT pass candidates would be called for sports skill trials.

(c) Candidates who qualify in PFT and selection trials for the game applied for will be called for medical fitness test conducted by the Air Force Medical team as IAF medical standards.

(d) Those who are declared medically fit by the medical would be enrolled in IAF in Gp 'Y' trade as an outstanding sportsman.

# **GENERAL**

16. (a) The decision of selection committee/Air Force Sports Control Board in all matters relating to eligibility acceptance or rejection of application etc shall be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence shall be entertained in this regard. (b) Candidates must appear in the selection trials at New Delhi. (c) REQUESTS FOR CHANGE OF VENUE FOR SELECTION TRIALS OR DATE OF SELECTION TRIAL SHALL NOT BE ENTERTAINED. (d) However in case of non availability of sports infrastructure of a particular sports in Delhi. AFSCB reserve the right to Control Board will be final and binding on me. hold trials outside Delhi. Intimation/call letters would be sent accordingly. (e) Candidates not reporting for the trial on due date and time shall not be accommodated on other dates/shifts. (f) Incomplete application shall be rejected. (g) Candidates should prepared to stay for the entire duration of the selection trials and medical examination in Delhi/place mentioned in call letter which they have to make their own arrangement. No TA/DA shall be admissible. (h) Candidates who are less than 18 years age on the date of trial should get the consent form, duly signed by their parents/guardian while coming for the selection tria (The format of the consent form is given in the application format). (j) Candidates found under the influence of performance e hancing drugs while participating in selection trials or any time before the date of enrolment, shall be disqualified immediately. No candidate is permitted to grow hair and beard. Only Sikh candidates, whose religion prohibits the cutting off then hair or sha ing off face will be permitted to grow hair/retain beard and moustache. Those Sikh candidates willing to retain the same as p laid down specification are to get their photographs with beard and moustache. In any case, no candidate is permitted to gro beard without moustache irrespective of religion or faith. (I) Candidates discharged from Indian Army/Indian Navy/any other Go ernment Organisations are also eligible subject to their discharge with No Adverse Entries. Such candidate has to declare at the time of applying that he is an Ex-employee of the organisation discharged from and produce original discharge certificate at the time of appearing for selection trials. In case of serving individuals, they must be in possession of NOC from their employer at the time of selection trials. If any candidate dose not discloses the fact of being employed or that of being an ex-employee, his cand dature will be cancelled at any stage during the selection process or at any subsequent stage. Candidate discharged from India Air Force for any reason are not eligible to appear.
