Tie Principle:

Tie cases (wherever two or more candidates have secured equal aggregate marks) occurring in the merit order result of CAPF (ACs) Examination, 2025, have been resolved in accordance with the following revised tie breaking principle as approved by the commission:-

- (i) If the marks in aggregate (Final Marks) are equal, the candidate securing more marks in the written total is ranked higher;
- (ii) If the marks at (i) above are equal, the candidate securing more marks in "Paper-I: General Ability & Intelligence" is ranked higher; and
- (iii) If the marks at (i) and (ii) above are also equal, the candidate senior in age is ranked higher.
